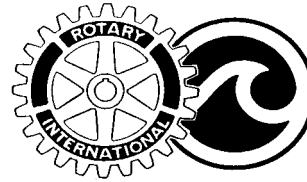

Kristy Bradish, Winnebago County Conflict Resolution, spoke to us last Friday. The County Conflict Resolution is in its eighteenth year. The group handles a wide range of disputes, from pet goldfish to \$1 million dollar business disagreements.

They are funded primarily by grants and training fees. They train their own as well as other conflict resolution specialists. They currently have 50 volunteers. Many of them specialize in various types of conflicts.

In handling 439 cases last year, all the time treating each party with respect and accepting their statements as their individual truths. They are trained to treat all parties with respect and hear them out.

55% of the clients are low income. The Conflict Resolution councilors often help these clients take responsibility for their actions by working out time to make settlements. Very often these conflicts are tenant vs. landlord issues.

The goal of the councilors is to lead the clients to recognize their own solutions

to their problems.
