Lt. Governor Bill Wresch, District 6270 spoke at our Club last week.

Background on the District

Governor: Bill Wresch joined Rotary in 1988 and served as President of the Stevens Point Rotary Club in 1996-1997. He moved to Oshkosh and joined the Oshkosh Southwest Rotary Club in 1997 and was President from 2001-2002.
