The reason these mechanical cows is important, is they will increase the nutritional health of the community, create job opportunities, encourage community development and increase social awareness.

Soy milk is high in nutritional value. One glass of Soy milk is equivalent to 4 helpings of meat protein. For every pound of soy beans you can produce 5 liters of soy milk and the machines are capable of producing 100 liters of milk per hour.

Southwest Club is starting two more locations in addition to the three machines already in operation. The new locations are Rimak and Piata; both poor neighborhoods were protein is hare to come by for the children.
